

- A. Swamp Milkweed (Asclepias incarnata), at least 3 plants
- B. Butterfly Weed (Asclepias tuberosa), at least 3 plants
- **C.** Anise Hyssop
- D. Echinacea
- **E.** Spotted Joe-Pye Weed (*Eutrochium maculatum*)
- F. Blazing Star (*Liatris*)
- **G.** Asters such as 'October Sky' or Raydon's Favorite or Ageratum (Eupatorium coelestinum)
- H. Black-eyed Susan (Rudbeckia fulgida) and Miss Huff Lantana, one of each
- I. Prairie Dropseed grass or Coreopsis (*Verticillata*, '*Moonbeam*') or Large flowered Coreopsis (*Coreopsis grandiflora*) or Stokes Aster, or New England Aster
- **J.** Little Bluestem grass or Showy Goldenrod (Solidago speciosa) or Aster, Smooth Blue (Symphyotrichum laeve)
- **K.** Mountain Mint (*Pycnanthemum virginianum*)
- L. Rattlesnake Master (*Eryngium yuccifolum*)
