All Sponsors and Virtual Exhibitors are invited to provide a pre-recorded **video or Zoom presentation**, 1-3 minutes in length, that will be shown to ALL Symposium registrants at least two times during the 3-day symposium, between the speaker presentations (see detailed Symposium schedule on page 4). In addition, the video will also be shown during the time before the Symposium begins on Saturday (12:00-12:15pm) and/or Sunday (12:30-1:00pm). This provides an opportunity for you to describe your company or organization, your products and services, and to offer special incentives to captive Symposium attendees. If you will be selling or exhibiting at our March 27th Outdoor Native Plant Marketplace, this will be an excellent opportunity to inform our audience about what you offer. If you do not already have a pre-recorded video about your company, we can assist you in recording a short presentation in a Zoom format. Recordings of all speaker, sponsor and exhibitor presentations will be available in a password-protected website for six months after the Symposium.

OUTDOOR NATIVE PLANT MARKETPLACE – Saturday, March 27, 2021

The Outdoor Native Plant Marketplace will be held at the **First Horizon Pavilion**, **located at 1801 Carter St.**, **Chattanooga**, **TN 37408**. Adjacent to Finley Stadium in downtown Chattanooga, the First Horizon Pavilion is an open-air, 50,000 sq. ft. covered pavilion, which can accommodate 3,000 to 4,000 attendees. A familiar location for local residents, the Pavilion is home to the seasonal Chattanooga Market, a local food and arts market which runs every Sunday, May-November each year. There are 2,000 parking spaces nearby.

The Outdoor Native Plant Marketplace will be open to the public from 9:00 am – 3:00 pm on Saturday, March 27, 2021, rain or shine. For the safety of all, mask wearing will be required. This is a selling marketplace. Cash and carry sales are permitted, but not required.

Exhibitor/Vendor Set-up: The First Horizon Pavilion will be open for set-up beginning at 7:00 am on Saturday, March 27, 2021. Exhibitors must provide staffing, tables, chairs, signage and display materials. Electrical hookups will be available. Free parking for your truck or vehicle will be available in a designated lot.

Our Volunteer Coordinator(s) will be in touch and confirm your set-up location in the Marketplace in advance.

Exhibit/Booth take-down may begin at 3:00 pm on Saturday, March 27, 2021.
